Why do we need you?

This year F&BF will be hosting the 6th London Faith & Belief Community Awards at the iconic Westminster Abbey. To mark this special occasion, we are looking for an artist or collective to create a creative output that will contribute to our aims of leveraging exposure for the interfaith sector as a whole and championing faith and belief-inclusive initiatives across London.

What will you be doing?

You will be collaborating with F&BF staff and our youth council to create an artistic output i.e., photographs, illustrations, a short film, or social media campaign. This work would be exhibited at the event and on our website, with the volunteer artists credited. There is also potential that this work would be shown at future events or through continued social media campaigns, partly down to the artists own motivation and how they shape the output.

Through this voluntary role you will get to meet the 30+ inspirational faith and belief projects that work at the grassroots level to create a fairer and more inclusive London. Your work will help tell their stories to a wider audience (including statutory bodies, funders and decision makers) and celebrate the impact their work has.

When are you needed?

The London Faith & Belief Community Awards takes place on Wednesday 23rd November. We would like to work with someone from mid-October to the end of November.

Who is right for the role?

- Open, inclusive, and proactive attitude and approach to your work.
- Creative and innovative, with good working knowledge of visual art and practical techniques.
- Ability to interact with a range of stakeholders.
- Work effectively within a team.
- An interest in and passion for interfaith and intercultural dialogue.

What impact will you have?

By volunteering at F&BF, you will help create positive spaces for people to meet others different from themselves and engage in important discussions around faith, belief, and identity and help project the voices of unsung heroes. Many of our events are about celebrating faith and belief-based communities and so by giving your time you will be helping recognise this important work.

We hope that volunteering with us will have an impact on you! It's an amazing opportunity to experience interfaith in action and meet new people.

What will you gain for the experience?

By volunteering at our events, you will:

- Join a movement of people passionate about bringing people together from different backgrounds
